In Celebration of Israel's 70th Birthday and Sheba's 70th Anniversary

Monday, June 11, 2018 – Welcome to Israel

VIP greeting service at the plane door, car service to passport control and baggage claim and luxury transfer from the airport to the Hilton in Tel Aviv.

In the evening, we will make our way by VIP shuttle to the private residence of one of Sheba Medical Center's donors for a welcome dinner.

Tuesday, June 12, 2018 – Tour of Northern Israel

Depart the hotel after breakfast and enjoy Israel's coastline views as we head north, through the Galilee, on our way to the Golan Heights.

Ascend Mount Bental, overlooking the Northern border, and hear a briefing from the Brigade Medical Officer of the IDF Golan Territorial Division. You will better appreciate Israel's concerns and its implications on the daily life of the local residents.

The Golan Heights is well known for its production of wine. We will visit one of Israel's leading wineries for a special lunch and a private tour.

Self-drive RZR (buggies) through the fields and orchards, and stop to pick ripe cherries.

Optional: Helicopter ride to the Golan Heights and back (for an additional cost)

Lunch at Sheba Medical Center followed by a brief tour of the Edmond and Lily Safra Children's Hospital.

Partake in the Grand Opening of the new Claudio Cohen Department of Pediatric Intensive Care and the Edmond and Lily Safra Children's Hospital Pediatric Internal Medicine Wing.

Return to the hotel to freshen up.

Early evening tour of the magical streets of Old Jaffa. Experience dinner at Spoons over stimulating dialogue with a leading Middle East investigative journalist.

Thursday, June 14, 2018 – Jerusalem of Gold

After breakfast, depart the hotel to Jerusalem in our VIP shuttle.

Attend a private audience with Israel's President Mr. Reuven Rivlin, followed by an honorary reception for Sheba donors at the President's Residence.

Lunch will take place at the luxurious Mamilla Hotel overlooking the Old City walls.

Following lunch, we will go on an enthralling private tour of the recently uncovered (not yet open to the general public) Western Wall Tunnels. An opportunity to touch the 2,000-year old stones and take a journey through time to Israel's ancient past and bear witness to one of Israel's most glorious and significant archeological findings.

Return to the hotel for rest and relaxation (optional train ride back to Tel Aviv pending opening of the new railway between Jerusalem and Tel Aviv).

Saturday, June 16, 2018 – Day of Rest

Option 1: Caesarea and Zichron Yaakov

Visit Zihron Ya'akov, first settled by Jewish youth in 1882 and today a pleasant town with a famous winery. Carry on to Caesarea, one of Israel's foremost Roman and Crusader relics. The tour will include light lunch. *Minimum guests per tour: 6*

Option 2: Acre and Haifa Rosh Hanikra

Acre was the Crusaders' Kingdom in the 12th Century and offers impressive remains. Later, enjoy the steep cable car ride down to Rosh Hanika's caves which offer a beautiful sensory experience. The tour will include light lunch. *Minimum guests per tour: 6*

Option 3: Masada and; the Dead Sea

Descend to the lowest spot on Earth. Visit the famous stronghold of Jewish revolts against the Romans and hear of their heroic struggle. The tour will include light lunch at one of the Dead Sea hotels and entrance to the hotel spa. *Minimum guests per tour: 6*

Option 4 (pending availability):

Visit the newly opened Arad Racing track, a sign that motor sports are on the rise in Israel.

Dinner with a private chef will be held at a restaurant in Tel Aviv.

Monday, June 18, 2018 – Israel's Cutting-Edge Technology & Journey to Space

A visit to SpaceIL – Landing the first Israeli Spacecraft on the Moon.

SpaceIL's goal is to inspire the next generation of children in Israel and around the world to think differently about science, technology, engineering and math (STEM). Space IL is committed to using the Google Lunar X Prize money to promote science and scientific education in Israel, to ensure that Israel will continue to live up to its reputation for excellence in these fields. Space IL is collaborating with a range of educational partners in the development of learning platforms, content and curriculum.

Following the visit, we will make our way to Tel Aviv for a light "Pita lunch" at Hakosem.

After lunch, explore Tel Aviv and see how the city was awarded with a UNESCO World Heritage Site named the White City.

Evening tour of Tel Aviv to get a small taste of the city that never sleeps.

Farewell Dinner with Israel's top Chef Eyal Shani at his secret place hosted by Israel's leading entertainer Einat Saruf.
